

THE LAST QUARTER

Since my last quarterly newsletter Winter has come & gone. Demand for Planners has been steady from my perspective, but no doubt some companies still have a "steady as she goes" mentality, and airport work is still dead in the water.

Hopefully now that the UK is rolling out Covid-19 vaccines & doing very well at this, hopefully the UK companies & economy can get confidence back start recruiting more, meaning more job opportunities for Planners. Interviews are currently still 95% of the time being done by video call.

Pre-Covid-19 I had never set up a video interview, but I see this staying for good now, with maybe a 50/50 split or 60/40 in one direction or the other. So if you are doing a video interview make sure you prepare & present yourself in the same way you would prepare for a face-to-face interview.

Covid-19 has also seen many Planners working from home (WFH), or not needing to be in a company office.

I believe employers will or should remain open to this post-Covid-19, however I do not see WFH being a 5 day a week option, as visiting site is so important for construction & infrastructure projects.

Depending on who you speak to, some projects are busy, others less so (airports) for obvious reasons.

There are jobs out there for sure, mainly permanent hires, as many companies have taken Covid-19, economic uncertainty & IR35 as reasons to cull or reduce contract workers. How this will look in the months & years ahead is anyone's guess, but demand for contract workers right now is non-existent.


Another change I've seen in the last 3 months is those Planners I supply to European companies' or projects, if these people are UK passport holders who could move freely to Europe for work; this has now become more difficult due to Brexit.

Many of the companies that I supply are now asking me for EU passport holders or Planners based in country that already have a valid visa.

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Job registrations for the period Jan to March 2021 are up 33% from 21 jobs the previous quarter to 28 jobs; however, as you will see from the graph below job registrations are down 32% from the same period a year ago when 41 jobs were registered.



CHANCELLOR ANNOUNCES INVESTMENT AND TAX CHANGES IN BUDGET

Facing an unprecedented peacetime financial outlook, Chancellor Rishi Sunak announced a raft of bold measures which look set to boost the UK construction industry.

Singling out construction to illustrate the new 'Super Deduction' policy, Sunak stated "Under the existing rule, a construction firm buying £10 million of new equipment could reduce their taxable income in the year they invest by just £2.6 million. With the super deduction they can now reduce it by £13 million. We've never tried this before in our country, the OBR (Office for Budget Responsibility) have said it will boost business investment by 10%, around £20billion more per year." The new policy will run for two years from 1 April 2021 to 31 March 2023.
