

THE LAST QUARTER

Summer is here, but as always the weather in the UK is inconsistent. Happily the demand for Planners is not inconsistent. Demand for Planners is strong & I have been working on jobs all over the UK and Europe. I believe that demand will continue to be strong for the rest of 2021, fingers crossed.

It is great to see that many companies are very busy, some are the busiest that they have ever been. Most companies continue to allow their employees to have flexible working, working from home & only having to go to the site or the office as is necessary. Interviews are currently still 95% of the time being done by video call, I've only had a few people called for an office based face-to-face interview in the last quarter.

I'm also getting employers being more flexible when hiring, often stating that 2-3 days a week can be home based, as long as productivity is as good. That is something good to come from the last 12 months. Employers & employees ability to work from home & hopefully get a better work life balance. Long may this continue.

Demand for Planners & Project Controllers.

Interestingly for the European based jobs that I work on, due to Brexit, employers are now seeking persons that have an EU passport or already live in country, so that they have a valid visa. Having people from the UK fly over fortnightly is becoming less desirable & only time will see if it it stays this way.

There is also increasing interest in Planners that have 4D software expertise, mainly Synchro or Navisworks. I have written an article on this which you can read here: https://bit.ly/3xloOlv


I also always have employers seeking Planners that have a site management, site engineer or civil engineer background prior to moving into Planning.


Demand for freelance or contracted workers is still lower that I have ever know. I believe that employers have used IR35 to concentrate on hiring permanent hires only & many employers will not complete a CEST assessment for freelance workers, meaning that those freelance workers fall inside IR35, will then have lower NET take home pay, so many have decided to take staff jobs, for how long they will do that who knows.

Job registrations for the period April to June 2021 are up 25% from 28 jobs the previous quarter to 35 jobs; plus, you can see from the graph below that job registrations are up 119% from the same period a year ago when only 16 jobs were registered.
