

THE LAST QUARTER

I remain very busy although I registered less jobs in the last three months than in the same period 1 and 2 years ago. I do not read too much into this, as I had so many jobs to work on, I was not actively seeking new job registrations for much of this period. However, 10 new Planning jobs registered per month is still good.

In terms of what's been happening in the world of Construction & Infrastructure Planning. From my perspective things are remain good, demand is high & I have had & continue to have an abundance of great jobs vacancies, fluctuating between 30-45 live job vacancies in the period from Oct. to Dec/ 2023.


The challenges that I have found for the last year is just the lack of people choosing to make a job move, or sometimes if they are looking to make a job move, their expectations are a little off as to what employers are prepared to pay. This is why I love to have ongoing relationships with Planners and employers, so that we are always working together to identify a perfect job for the job seeker, or a perfect fit Planner for an employer.

In the 4th quarter of 2023, I registered 29 new job vacancies, (2,2 a week), compared to 41 (3.15 a week) new job vacancies the quarter before, & down from 54 from the same period last year (2022). As I said previously, I had to reduce my marketing at some stages over the last 9 months, due to being overwhelmed with work at times. I also took a 5-day holiday break in this quarter, so you can see that demand really is good. It's a great time to be a Planner as I often say.

I continue to work on jobs vacancies located all over the UK, Ireland & mainland Europe & fingers crossed demand will continue to be strong, however, in the crazy world that now we seem to be living in these last 2-3 years, who knows. Jan to March historically for me on average has seen an uplift in the jobs registered compared to the quarter before. Whatever happens, like always I will get my head down & continue to work hard every day, helping as many employers & Planners/ Project Controllers as I can.

THE LAST QUARTER

Job registrations for the period Oct. to Dec. 2023 are down 29% from 41 jobs the previous quarter to 29 jobs & job registrations are down 46% from the same period a year ago when 54 jobs were registered.

Current trends

- Most 1st interviews continue to be via video calls.
- Hybrid working seems to be accepted by most companies, with at least 1 day working from home accepted by most companies.
- Demand for Planners is still 90-95% for permanent/ staff.
- Lots of demand for EU passport holders, with data centre, pharmaceutical or life science building experience.

Contract jobs are scarce, and most jobs are still predominantly being deemed by the employer to be inside IR35. Many companies are not conducting a CEST assessment at all, it's more a case of their policy being that all contracts will be deemed inside IR35 regardless. Very frustrating.

The demand for Planners to be based full-time on projects in mainland Europe continues to grow as I continue to expand my client base.

Having an EU passport or valid visa for the country is key due to Brexit.

I am looking forward to a busy 2024. May 2024 be great for us all. I hope inflation & interest rates reduce, wars around the globe cease & governments pull their fingers out on the earth's environment & humans' impact on it.
