

## CELEBRATION NEWS HONORED AS BRONZE STEVIE® AWARD WINNER IN 2021 AMERICAN BUSINESS AWARDS®

The Celebration News Magazine and publication editor J.R. Rupp were named the winner of a Bronze Stevie® Award in the Best Newsletter category in The 19th Annual American Business Awards®.

The American Business Awards are the U.S.A.'s premier business awards program. All organizations operating in the U.S.A. are eligible to submit nominations – public and private, for-profit and non-profit, large and small.

Nicknamed the Stevies for the Greek word meaning "crowned," the awards will be virtually presented to winners during a live event on Wednesday, June 30. Tickets for the virtual event are now on sale.

More than 3,800 nominations – a record number - from organizations of all sizes and in virtually every industry were submitted this year for consideration in a wide range of categories, including Startup of the Year, Executive of the Year, Best New Product or Service of the Year, Marketing Campaign of the Year, Virtual Event of the Year, and App of the Year, among others. Celebration News was nominated in the Best Newsletter Category.
