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
# AS SEE

Happy New Year to everyone! As 2024 unfolds, let's look at what lies ahead for Siena. Our Homeowners Association's (HOA) Board of Directors, along with FirstService Residential, the HOA's management company, are committed to providing top-notch service to all members and residents. This includes managing operations, maintenance, and renovations with minimal disruption.

Much of the work to operate the community is not visible to most of us but operates in a similar manner to a small-medium size business. However, instead of producing a product or service for sale, the end product is providing services and fully functional, safe, and enjoyable amenities for all of us. Services include maintaining and operating the Community and Fitness Centers, swimming pools, tennis, pickleball and bocce ball courts, and the upkeep and ongoing repair and renovation of the community's common areas.

Included in November's annual budget mailer, which all members should have received, was the Reserve Expenditure Schedule. This document detailed a comprehensive list of recommendations by the Reserve Specialist for the repair, renovation, and replacement of our common area assets. While much of this work is subtly managed by our staff and may not be immediately noticeable, it plays a crucial role in maintaining our community's high standards.

Notably, the most significant and visible projects planned for 2023 and extending into 2024 and beyond involve the renovation of our landscape and irrigation systems. In the past, major landscaping efforts focused on median strips along Fiore Bella and the community's perimeter, as well as recent enhancements at the Community and Fitness Centers. Our ongoing and future landscape initiatives aim to rejuvenate areas with over 20-year-old flora, replacing dead, dying, or unsuitable plant species for our desert environment. This effort includes upgrading the sub-surface irrigation systems to prevent water waste from leaks and to optimize water usage through a smart water management system. The goal is not only to enhance our community's aesthetics but also to reduce water consumption and anticipated cost increases in the long run.



The majority of the renovation work, whether for the buildings, furnishings, roads, landscaping, pools, or other equipment, is paid for from the Siena Reserve Fund. While the community continues to build up the reserve fund through additional assessment increases, the Siena Investment Committee actively works to supplement the reserve fund through earnings from good investment management. Through 2023, the Federal Reserve has been increasing interest rates which resulted in an increase in the cost of goods and services for all of us. Meanwhile, the Investment Committee has taken advantage of the higher interest rates, investing the reserve fund balance in both US Treasuries and insured CDs (Nevada Revised Statutes provide that HOA investments are limited to guaranteed or insured products). The community has an investment ladder with investments maturing and reinvested monthly with guaranteed rates through mid-2025. The earnings are subject to federal income tax, so we don't net the whole gain. Recently, the Federal Reserve has indicated it may reverse the trend of increasing rates and reduce them during 2024, which will impact the income stream.

An additional annual boost to the reserve account would be the passage of the Capital Contribution Amendment, so if you haven't voted "YES" yet please return the ballot or contact the Resident Services desk for a replacement.

Also, a first for Siena, the Operating Account is now invested in "Money Market" funds, thereby earning interest on all of Siena's cash assets. The benefit, of course, is that along with operating fund transfers to reserves, investment earnings help build the reserve fund balance on a steady path to pay for future renovation expenses, and, hopefully, offset future anticipated cost increases.

Lastly, my annual reminder. Regardless of the age of the heating and cooling system in your home, have it checked by an HVAC service company before the cold weather sets in or warm weather returns. It's a small investment that can offer comfortable returns.







In 2005, the Nevada State Legislature passed a law to provide property tax relief referred to as the "Tax Cap", to homeowners. NRS 361.4723 provides a partial abatement of taxes by applying a 3% cap on the tax bill of the owner's primary residence (single-family house, townhouse, condominium, or manufactured home) and a higher cap 8%, on the tax bill of other properties. Some rental dwellings may also qualify for a 3% cap on the tax bill. Only one property may be selected in the State of Nevada as a primary residence. Be aware that any changes to the ownership on your parcel to include putting it in a trust, i.e. remove or add someone to title, buy or sell a home, change your primary residence or refinance the home may change your tax rate and you may need to request a correction.

As homeowners, you are always able to correct your Tax Cap if it is incorrect. Annually, the Assessor's Office mails out Tax Cap Abatement Notices to residential property owners who purchased property or had a change in ownership after July 1. If you are eligible for the primary tax cap rate for the upcoming fiscal year you may submit a claim by signing the bottom portion of the letter and returning it to the Assessor's Office by mail, online, or in person. You can also check your tax cap percentage by visiting the treasurer's webpage, trweb.co.clark.nv.us.

For investment property, rental dwellings that meet low-income rent limits may qualify for a 3% cap on the tax bill for 2024/2025 based on the type of unit and the number of bedrooms.

In summary, If your tax cap rate is incorrect, either for a primary residence or income property, contact the Assessor's Office before the deadline of June 30, 2024 to correct your tax cap for 2024-2025.


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## **HOA** INSIDER

A key event in the early part of this year is the Level 1 Reserve Study, scheduled for the end of January, which is an integral part of our community's financial and operational planning.

This year, the Reserve Study will be conducted by the experienced team at Browning Group, specialists in reserve evaluations. Their role is to carry out a comprehensive on-site inspection, meticulously examining every element in our common areas. From the streets to the pools, roofs, and sports courts, each component will be closely scrutinized. This will help us accurately determine the lifespan and value of each component, which is essential for strategic planning. This initiative is not just a task for external experts, it will be a collaborative effort, with active guidance and input from our expert resident committee volunteers, our dedicated facilities manager, and myself. Our combined expertise and understanding of the Siena Community will guide this process, ensuring comprehensive and tailored outcomes.

Regular updates to the Reserve Study are essential to stay aligned with the natural aging of our buildings and amenities. While we conduct annual reviews, a thorough Level 1 Reserve Study is advisable every 3 to 5 years, keeping us compliant with regulations and aiding in informed decision-making.





As we ring in the New Year, let's raise a glass and toast the community's continued commitment to conserve water in 2024.

Since water is an extremely limited resource in our desert community, conservation is a top priority for us all and even the smallest actions can result in significant savings. The Southern Nevada Water Authority (SNWA) is currently working to achieve its goal of 86 gallons per capita per day (GPCD) by the year 2035; in 2022, Southern Nevada's GPCD was 104 and 2023 will be even lower. This new goal addresses changing conditions in the Colorado River Basin and recognizes that additional progress is needed to improve water efficiency and maximize the community's available water supply.

Although a wet winter combined with lower water demands increased Lake Mead water levels in 2023, it's important to know that one good year of favorable hydrology will not reverse the decadeslong drought along the Colorado River, as Lake Mead levels are still down more than 140 feet.

By conserving water at home, you can help the community save our limited water supply. Let's make water conservation part of everyone's New Year's resolutions. Here are some ways you can save:

- Change Your Watering Clock Each Season: It's one of the simplest yet best ways to conserve water in Southern Nevada and it can help you save money, improve the health of your landscape, and avoid water waste fines. Mandatory winter watering restrictions in effect now through Feb. 29, which limit watering to one assigned day per week. Watering is never allowed on Sundays.
- **Upgrade to a Water Smart Landscape:** Convert your thirsty-grass to water-efficient plants and trees through the SNWA's Water Smart Landscapes Rebate Program (WSL) and get a cash incentive of up to \$3 per square foot. Plus, earn a bonus of \$100 for every qualified tree installed.
- Find and Fix Leaks: Household leaks can be silent and costly. Find out how you can detect, locate, and repair leaks in your home at snwa.com.
- Report and Prevent Water Waste: From irrigation overspray to leaking lines, water waste drains our community's limited water supply. Your local water provider offers on-line tools including apps for your mobile device to help report water waste anonymously; also, take time to inspect your property's irrigation system for leaks to help save water and money on your monthly bills.




