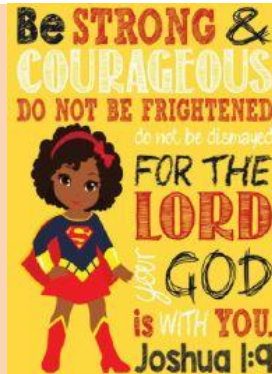

He is the original superhero but unlike the other superhero’s he shares his power.”



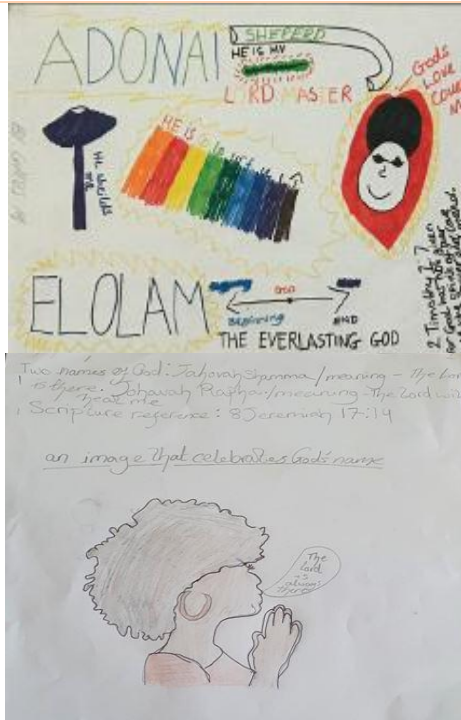

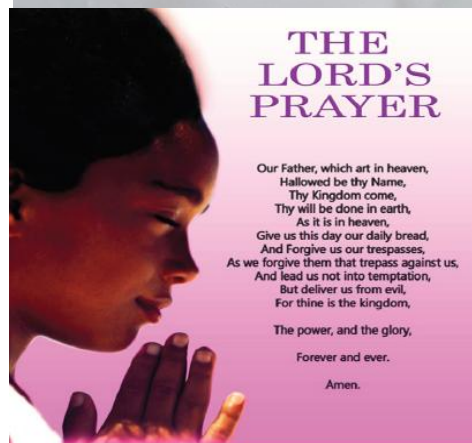
