- Confidence that it will perform exactly as expected under real show conditions

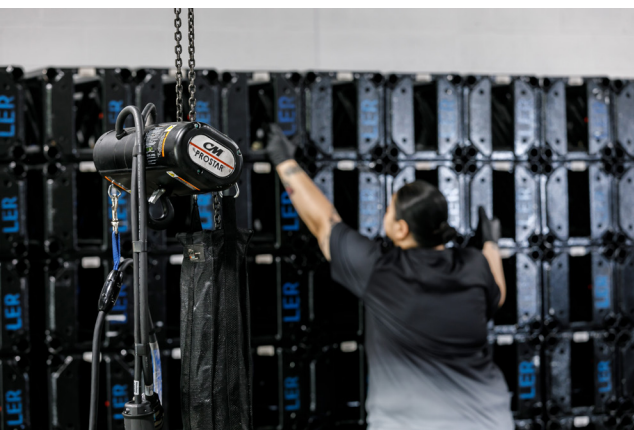

Well-planned equipment packages reduce:

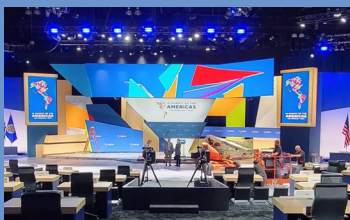
