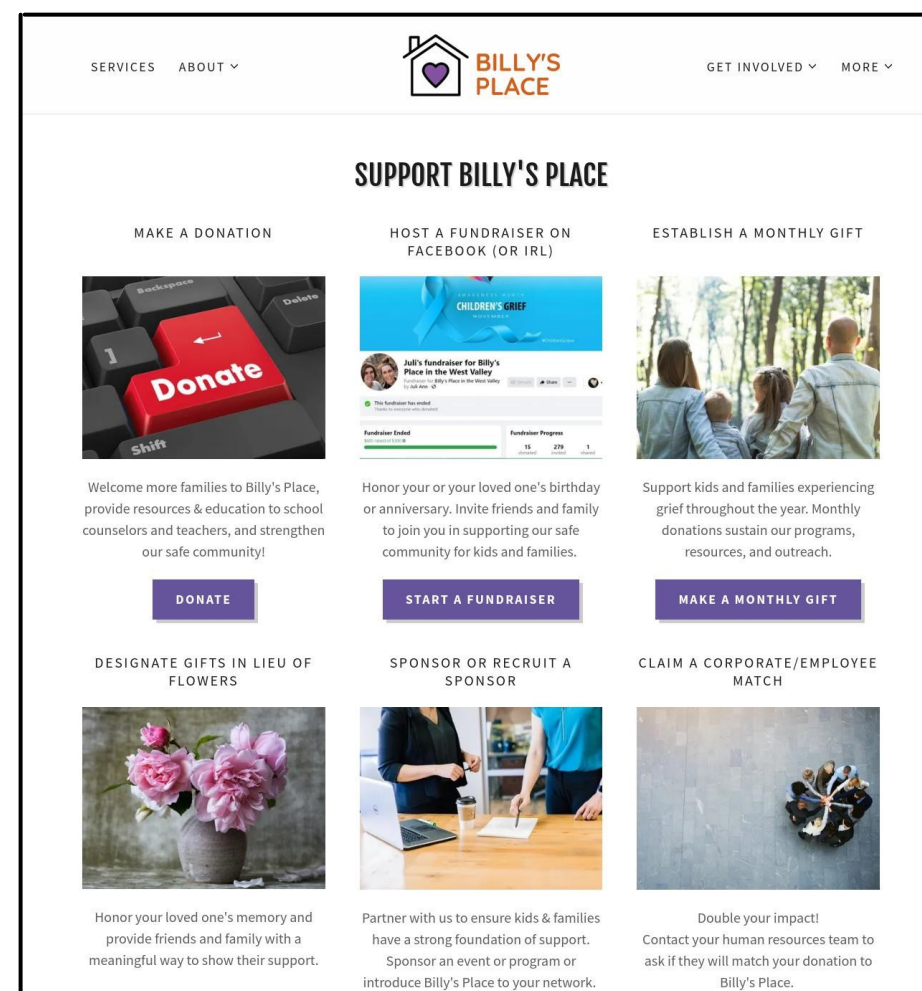

EXPANDED TRAINING FOR COUNSELORS, TEACHERS & SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS

Teachers, school counselors, nurses, and administrators are on the frontlines for kids experiencing grief -- the first responders. Partnering with the New York Life Foundation, we visit schools to provide resources and training so they can best support the kids in their care. In the fall of 2020, we trained 153 educators and 25 schools locally.

Melody is our Director of Programs. She and Zoom became quick friends in 2020 when she pivoted immediately to keep our programs moving during a wild year! We would be lost without her.

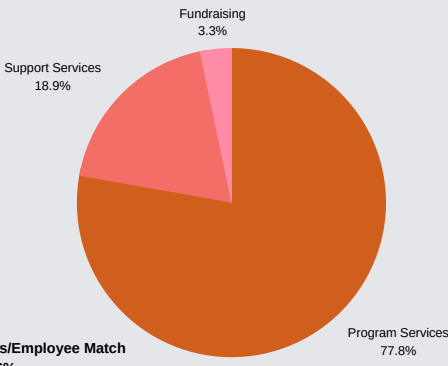
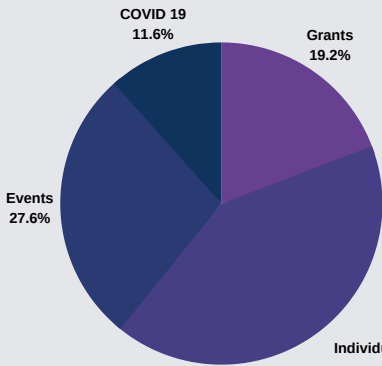


2020 BY THE NUMBERS
