

2024-2025 Fall PHA Series Rules and Regulations

Entry and show rules:

- You must show proof of current, negative Coggin for all horses/ponies. (This applies to all classes)
- Acceptable payment methods are cash, check or PayPal. Please note: If using PayPal, there will be a 3% fee since PayPal no longer allows for the friends/family transfer.
- There will be **NO REFUNDS** provided for scratched classes. The **ONLY** time a refund will be issued is if the show gets canceled due to inclement weather.
- Those who wish to compete for end of series awards must declare their desired division at the start of the first show in March. You may compete in multiple divisions within your WJ or WJL category.
- You may cross enter between WJ and WJL, however, you may not compete for high point awards in both. Example: If you picked open WJ for your series, you may cross enter WJL classes, however, it will NOT count towards any awards. This applies to both daily highpoint and end of year awards.
- Please refer to the below chart for a full breakdown of what classes will be counted for each division high point.
- In order to be eligible for daily highpoint awards, you **MUST complete in all the classes listed in the grid below for your respected division.**
- In order to be eligible for end of series awards, you **MUST compete in all classes listed in the grid below for your respective division.**
- In order to be eligible for end of series awards, you **MUST attend 3 of the 4 shows.**
- Points will be calculated on a horse and rider combination. The point scale used will be 6-5-4-3-2-1
- While memberships are encouraged, you **DO NOT** have to be a PHA member to be eligible for daily highpoints or end of series awards.
- Miniatures should remain within their specific classes with the exception of classes, 1, 2, 3, 40 and 41. These classes will be open to both miniatures and full-size horses.
- There should be no full-size horses or miniatures on the trail course prior to trail beginning. This ensures the measurements for obstacles do not get interfered with by accidental bumps by the horses. Riders/handlers may walk the course on foot if they wish.
- You should be checked in with the gate assistant at least ONE class prior to your class going in the ring. In an effort to keep the show running swiftly, there will only be a 30 second gate call.

Age Divisions (ages as of 1/1/2024):

Leadline: 6 & under

Youth: 17 & under

18 & Over: Non-Professionals

Open: All ages including professionals

Entry fees: individual class fees -- \$10.00; Office/grounds fee -- \$20.00

High point divisions and classes to enter to be eligible:

NOTE: Horse and rider combination must enter all five classes listed for a division to be eligible for high point in that division.
