Setting	Typical Total Cost (Facility + Provider) *	Out-of-Pocket (Insured)**
Emergency Department (non-admitted)	\$700 – \$1,300+ per visit	\$250 – \$500 copay + coinsurance
Urgent Care (in person)	\$150 – \$250 per visit	\$30 – \$75 copay
Primary Care Office Visit (in person)	\$100 – \$150	\$25 – \$65 copay
Amaze Health (from your home or office)	\$35/month – group rate (unlimited visits – covers family)	\$0 copay

Preventive & Wellness Care • Annual wellness visits and health risk assessments • Lifestyle counseling (nutrition, exercise, weight management, smoking cessation) • Medication reviews and refills • Health screenings (blood pressure, diabetes risk, mental health questionnaires) • Chronic condition check-ins and review of local lab results • Vaccination guidance and scheduling with local clinics	Chronic Disease Management • Hypertension (high blood pressure) • Diabetes (type 2) – review of glucose logs, medication adjustments • High cholesterol • Asthma/COPD maintenance • Thyroid disorders • Obesity & metabolic syndrome • Arthritis (mild/moderate)
Acute Illness & Symptom Care • Cold, flu, sinus infections, sore throat, bronchitis • Allergies and asthma flare-ups • Urinary tract infections (UTIs) • Skin rashes, acne, minor infections (video for visual exams) • Stomach issues (nausea, diarrhea, heartburn) • Headaches, migraines, mild musculoskeletal pain	Diagnostic Coordination • Lab orders & imaging referrals to local facilities • Review and explanation of test results • Follow-up care planning based on lab/imaging findings
Mental & Behavioral Health • Screening & treatment for depression, anxiety, stress, and insomnia • Medication management for mood disorders (when appropriate) • Referrals to therapists, psychiatrists, or counseling services	Care Coordination & Other Services • Specialist referrals and follow-up after urgent care/ER visits • Guidance for home monitoring (blood pressure cuffs, glucometers) • Work, school, or sports physical forms (when no in-person exam required) • Travel health consultations and lifestyle coaching
