

On September 14, 2021, the District responded to Deputy District Attorney Jason Ring regarding your appeal involving your request for "Proposer Reference Forms." In our response we shared our position that these documents *would be* exempt under ORS 192.355(4) if there were any, but after performing a records check in response to the DA's appeal inquiry we determined that there in fact were no records responsive to your original request.

Mr. Ring determined that without any responsive records, there is no issue for appeal. He asked that the District communicate with you regarding the fact that on review, even though we maintain that the records were exempt, there were no records to provide. Having so informed you, I understand that Mr. Ring is prepared to close this matter.
