Bringing David into the conversation as he joined us this morning. Don, I want to thank you publicly here for being supportive of this work. It's a big commitment...and such an important one. I know you're not engaging in the work for the political win, but I think this one will serve as both a political and moral step forward.

Mike, I think we'll need to meet and talk about the legal/ethical obligations and limitations in terms of engaging with CEI for such a large contract, even if they are able to "chunk" it into segments of partnership. We also had questions about possible use of current and future SIA funding, and the potential of having staff use their PD/tuition reimbursement for the Equity Certificate program.

I'm happy to check in briefly today, though I am in meetings pretty consistently from 1:00-9:00. I could also check in before tomorrow's cabinet meeting, and I have a window between 2-4 tomorrow as well.
