**Gerardo Teissonnière** (born March 29, 1961, in <u>Ponce, Puerto Rico</u>) is a <u>Puerto Rican pianist</u> and <u>teacher</u>.

## **Education**

Gerardo Teissonnière studied at the Conservatory of Music in <u>Puerto Rico</u> with <u>Jesús María Sanromá</u> and at the <u>Cleveland Institute of Music</u> with <u>Vitya Vronsky</u> (<u>Vronsky & Babin</u>), both disciples of <u>Artur Schnabel</u> and <u>Alfred Cortot</u>, and at the Aspen Music Festival with Jeaneane Dowis, former assistant to <u>Rosina Lhévinne</u> at the Juilliard School. He also pursued post-graduate studies in Europe with <u>Dmitri Bashkirov</u> and Joaquín Achúcarro.

## **Professional career**

Since his American debut at the National Gallery of Art in Washington, D.C., Gerardo Teissonnière has given première performances of music by 20th-century composers such as Pablo Casals, Aaron Copland, Claude Debussy, Alberto Ginastera, Lowell Liebermann, Darius Milhaud, Arvo Pärt and Heitor Villa-Lobos. [1] In 2004 he embarked on a five-recital cycle presenting the complete Mozart piano sonatas. In 2005 he was invited to perform in Poland in conjunction with commemorative events of the 150th anniversary of Chopin's death and the fifteenth Chopin International Piano Competition. [2] Teissonniere has recorded for the Steinway & Sons label and is a Steinway Artist and faculty member of the Cleveland Institute of Music. [3]
