




4 Paws of Love Therapy


Dress Attire for Visits


The following is required of all teams (teams in training and certified teams) during visits:


 Only closed toed shoes be worn during visits.


 Casual, but appropriate attire (jeans and sneakers are acceptable as long as they do not have holes in them and are clean).

 We will eventually be wearing purple shirts with our logo on them, so we are asking people to start finding solid colored purple shirts - long or short sleeves. Any shirt style is acceptable except ones that expose your belly or have spaghetti straps. If you do not have a solid purple shirt, a solid white shirt is acceptable.


 A leash no more than 4 feet long is be used. If you have one longer than 4 feet, you can fold it over while holding it.

 You may want to carry a second leash with you in the event someone we visit holds on to the leash and will not release it.

 Carry wet wipes with you at all times in the event your dog licks someone, etc.

 Carry poop bags with you at all times in the event your dog needs to relieve him/herself.

 Carry a copy of the incident report with you at all times.

 We have found over the years that it is best not to carry a purse during the visits. Some sort of fanny pack, mini back pack, or sling over bag works best.
