What to do first after your diagnosis --- Find treatment and funding resources:

Okay, so you've downloaded the 100 day kits and received brochures from your doctor. What next?

1) First, in Colorado, find your COMMUNITY CENTERED BOARD./Case Management Agency Community Centered Boards (CCB) are the single entry point into the long-term service and support system for persons with developmental disabilities. There are 20 CCB's that deliver community-based services. CCBs provide case management services including intake, eligibility determination, service plan development, and arranging services.

Community Centered Boards may also provide services. They are private non-profit organizations designated in statute as the single entry point into the long-term service and support system for persons with developmental disabilities. The State contracts with twenty Community Centered Boards to deliver community-based services. Each CCB has a non-overlapping geographic service region of one to ten counties. CCBs are responsible case management services including intake, eligibility determination, service plan development, arrangement for services, delivery of services (either directly and/or through purchase), monitoring, and many other functions. Additionally, CCBs are responsible for assessing service needs and developing plans to meet those needs of their local service area. CCBs play a vital role in managing limited resources at the local level to meet the individual needs of its citizens and to address the overall needs of the local service area.



- 2.) Consider ABA (Applied Behavior Analysis)
 - > Check out brief description of ABA (resources below)
- 3.) Make a copy of your child's diagnosis to give to professionals when needed
- 4.) Obtain a PCP (physician) letter about ABA
 - Description: Obtaining a letter from your child's primary care physician recommending applied behavior analysis at the intensity required/needed for most effective treatment

5.) Research your insurance.

- Does your plan cover ABA? Call your broker and find out.

 - Description: "The guidelines were developed to provide guidance to health plans, consumers, and providers so that individuals diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder receive applied behavior analysis (ABA) treatment consistent with the best available scientific evidence and expert clinical opinion. This project was prompted by the recent passage of autism-insurance legislation in multiple states, which has left numerous insurers with a need to develop an infrastructure for defining and funding ABA treatment."

APPLIED BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS (ABA)

ABA is an evidence-based treatment model that builds on decades of research. ABA focuses on individualized learning

techniques to help people learn useful, adaptive behaviors. ABA is also useful in helping individuals in decreasing behaviors that are harmful, interfere with learning or socialization, or create difficulties in family or educational environments.

- ➤ **Providers of ABA are Behavior Analysts.** Behavior Analysts are certified by the BACB (Behavior Analysis Certification Board)
- The BACB (https://www.bacb.com/) defines Behavior Analysis as: The field of Behavior Analysis grew out of the scientific study of principles of learning and behavior. It has two main branches: experimental and applied behavior analysis. The experimental analysis of behavior is the basic science of this field and has over many decades accumulated a substantial and well-respected body of research literature. This literature provides the scientific foundation for applied behavior analysis, which is both an applied science that develops methods of changing behavior and a profession that provides services to meet diverse behavioral needs. Briefly, professionals in applied behavior analysis engage in the specific and comprehensive use of principles of learning, including operant and respondent conditioning, in order to address behavioral needs of widely varying individuals in diverse settings. Examples of these applications include: building the skills and achievements of children in school settings; enhancing the development, abilities, and choices of children and adults with different kinds of disabilities; and augmenting the performance and satisfaction of employees in organizations and businesses.

Applied Behavior Analysis is a well-developed discipline among the helping professions, with a mature body of scientific knowledge, established standards for evidence-based practice, distinct methods of service, recognized experience and educational requirements for practice, and identified sources of requisite education in universities. Although the above definitions provide an overview of key elements within the practice of behavior analysis, there are additional features of applied behavior analysis that should be clarified in order to even briefly define the field. 
