From March 8 to May 2, 2025, the Hendrik Christian Andersen House Museum, part of the Pantheon and Castel Sant'Angelo Institute - National Museums Directorate of the City of Rome, will host the group exhibition "Femininity. 6 Artists for the Hendrik Andersen House Museum".

Curated by Maria Giuseppina Di Monte, the exhibition is conceptually linked to a previous one held at the Hendrik Andersen House Museum between 2016 and 2017, titled "Feminine and Feminine: Women at Andersen's House". That exhibition explored the role of the women in the Andersen family–Olivia, the artist's sister-in-law; Lucia, his adoptive sister; and, above all, his mother Helene, the central figure and reference point of the family. Through Hendrik's works, it investigated the androgynous spirit intrinsic to his artistic production.

Now, nearly a decade later, the museum's halls will once again feature the works of various artists, both women and men, from different cultures and nations, united by a sensibility that echoes that same "androgyny of the spirit".

The exhibition presents six artists: **Salome Rigvava, Sara Basta, Dario Carratta, Winna Go, Kawita Vatanajyankur, and Tang Shuo,** who employ a variety of techniques in their works. These range from traditional oil painting, as seen in the works of Salome Rigvava, Winna Go, and Tang Shuo, to more experimental approaches involving textiles and

object combinations, as in the case of Sara Basta, as well as video and performance art, utilized by Kawita Vatanajyankur.

Exhibition curator Maria Giuseppina Di Monte states:

"The variety of materials, apparent contrasts, and evocative atmospheres of each work offer reflections on femininity and its role as a key element in rediscovering a more authentic sense of coexistence. It is an opportunity to celebrate difference as a space for dialogue and a source of mutual enrichment."
