## **RSV Symptoms By Age**



**INFANTS / CHILDREN** 

- Bronchitis
- Pneumonia
- Irritable
- Fatigue
- Fever
- Cough
- Wheezing
- · Difficulty breathing



**ADULTS** 

- Typical cold symptoms
- Cough
- Runny nose
- Sore throat
- Fatigue
- Fever
- Decreased appetite



ELDERLY

- Dry cough
- Headache
- Fever
- Bronchitis
- Pneumonia
- Sore throat
- Aggravating preexisting asthma or COPD

## Covid-19 And RSV

COVID-19 most often causes respiratory symptoms that can feel much like a cold, the flu, or pneumonia COVID-19 spreads
when an infected
person breathes out
droplets and very small
particles that contain
the virus.

RSV can be dangerous for infants and some young children.

Nearly every child will get RSV by the time they are 2 years old. This is different from adults, who can sometimes get RSV and not have any symptoms.

Infants who get RSV almost always show symptoms.
