The Eagle Excellence, Award



Started with the class of 2009

This award will be presented to Graduating High School Seniors that have soared above the crowd during their high school bowling career. A bowler must meet the following four demanding criteria to be eligible to receive this prestigious award. The NIBPA must approve each nomination. *Bowlers may be nominated by any High School Coach*. More than one bowler may win this award.

- <u>Criteria #1</u> Bowler must have bowled at least **2** *years on Varsity*. Varsity = 18 games minimum on the varsity team or 2/3 of session
- <u>Criteria #2</u> Bowler must have been selected to an **ALL Conference Team**.

 Honorable Mention does not count
- <u>Criteria #3</u> Bowler must have participated in an *IHSA State Tournament*.

 <u>2020-21 Season only</u> = a top 5 finish in NIC-10 Top 16 tournament, a top 3 finish in NIBC Top 10 tournament, or a top 10 varsity series finish in the NIBPA Post-Season tournament. If you feel your bowler should be considered that has not met this criteria, a NIBPA committee will review/decide.
- Criteria #4 Bowler must have contributed back to the bowling community.

 Participation in Bowln' 4 Kids only requires a minimum of \$250 or

 Volunteer Youth / Middle School Coach, etc. plus a minimum of \$50 for Bowln' 4 Kids
