All board artwork submissions must be complete and provided to us by the deadline.

Whatever your medium, we believe that your artistic talent would be a perfect fit for our upcoming project. Get creative with supplies and techniques – submissions can go beyond just paint. The common factor for all art submissions is that they must incorporate at least one skateboard deck. Any size deck may be used, with or without wheels. Please let us know if you need assistance in getting a skateboard deck.

Artists grant Waterford Skate Park a non-exclusive licence to use and sell board artwork submissions for fundraising purposes.
