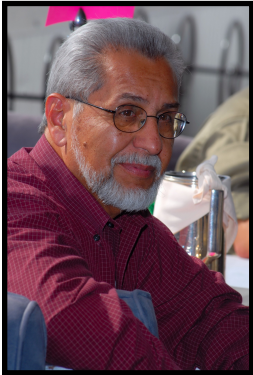

José Aguayo/ "What's in a Name."

Jose Aguayo will make a presentation at the monthly CSHG meeting on April 18, titled: "What's in a Name." In this presentation, Aguayo investigates the origins and evolution of surnames from the Middle Ages to the present. Jose is the founder of the Museo de Las Americas and author of *The Color of Duty: Stories of Latinos in the American Military*, an International Latino Book Awards winner. He is also author of *Caciques y Conquistadores*, a historical novel and memoir.
