## Greatree Archery, NADA Set Coaching Seminar By Win & Win's Park

A coaching seminar and shooters school led by famed former Korean Olympic archery coach Kyung Rae Park has been scheduled in early April. This event is jointly hosted by National Alliance for the Development of Archery (NADA) and Greatree Archery, the U.S. distributor for Win&Win equipment, and is sanctioned by the National Archery Association.

It will be conducted at the Olympic Training Center at Chula Vista, California, April 8-10, and will be supervised on-site by Lloyd Brown, two-time US Olympic Archery Team Coach. The coaching seminar is from April 8-9, the Shooters School follows on April 10. The Coaching Seminar costs \$250 for each participant, and the Shooters School \$150 each. On-site lodging and meals is \$40 per day.

This seminar will offer a rare experience into the Korean coaching philosophy by the man who for years has dominated the Korean archery scene. Participants will learn the Korean shooting form, and how to teach this form. In addition, Coach Park will discuss recurve equipment tuning and effective training programs, secrets of famous Korean archers, and the mental aspect of Korean archery. He will also discuss choosing the proper equipment for young archers.

The Shooters School is open to all competitive recurve archers and will provide individual and group instructions from Coach Park. All participants are encouraged to bring their own equipment. To secure a position in the Coaching Seminar or Shooters School seminar, participants are to send in a non-refundable deposit of \$100 for each seminar to NADA, indicating the seminar(s) they wish to attend. The balance is due at the start of the seminar.
