Lee/Career High Schools Hall of Fame

2023-2024 Hall of Fame Overview

The Lee/Career HS Hall of Fame honors individuals whose outstanding accomplishments have contributed to the success and reputation of Lee/Career HS. In recognition of these efforts by alumni the HoF Committee is accepting nominations in the categories described below. We encourage people to think about who they might know who fits into a specific category instead of a generic nomination request where it may be unclear what the person was known for or has done to deserve induction.

In the Fall of 2023, the Lee/Career Hall of Fame Wall will be revealed at a public event at Career HS with those that were inducted in 2019 and 2022. The next Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony will be held in 2024.

People who are nominated but not inducted can still be considered in the following years, as is the case for professional sports hall of fame inductions. Individuals can be nominated and inducted posthumously. The Lee/Career Hall of Fame Committee will review the nominations and release the names of finalists in each category. Then a period of public voting will be open, with the votes of the public counting as one vote on the committee. Votes will be collected on-line and through regular mail.

ATHLETIC ACHIEVEMENT

For alumni, faculty, or staff who had superior accomplishments in sports either while at Lee/Career HS, or after graduation in college, professional or community sports as an athlete, coach, or sports administrator such as an Athletic Director.

HUMANITARIAN ACHIEVEMENT

For alumni, faculty or staff who have made a significant contribution to the nation or the world that has helped make it a better place to live. These honorees have achieved recognition for making a positive change to the human condition.

LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT

For alumni, faculty, or staff who have completed at least 40 years of their career or retired from their lifelong profession. They have achieved exceptional success in their professions and have contributed to the advancement of civic or service organizations.

PROFESSIONAL ACHIEVEMENT

For alumni, faculty, or staff who have achieved local, regional, or national distinction in their professions, who acknowledge the importance of their time at Lee/Career in reaching their goals and demonstrated loyalty to their school.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

For alumni, faculty, or staff who have provided long-term meaningful service through volunteer work with a local, regional, or national non-profit group. These inductees are considered to be instrumental to the organizations they serve.
