NOTE: You can claim only up to \$3,000 for the care of one person and up to \$6,000 for two or more. If you paid someone to watch over your two (or more) kids, you can combine all your care costs to reach the \$6,000 limit. The child has to be age 12 or under to qualify for the credit. The **maximum** credit is 35% that is, \$1,050 for the care of one person, \$2,100 for two or more. The 35 percent rate is only for lower-income taxpayers. If you make more than \$15,000, the credit percentage is incrementally phased down by salary range until it hits 20 percent for those earning more than \$43,000. Only working parents can claim the credit. In case of a married couple, both parents have to be working.
