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Criteria: Selection is based on demonstrated leadership, participation in school and community activities, and work experience. Applicants must be enrolled or planning to enroll as a full-time undergraduate in one of the following: an accredited two-year junior or community college, a two-year or four-year accredited vocational school or college, or a four-year college or university.

The award is offered for tuition and/or academic fees only and the recipient must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or above.

Awards: Individual Scholarship Awards are up to \$1,000 annually. Recipients may re-apply for each school year, up to four consecutive years. The amount of awards will be determined by the Scholarship Committee and are subject to change, at any time, based on the availability of funds.

Application: Applicants must submit:

- Completed CES Application Title Page
- Statement of goals and aspirations, note any unusual circumstances
- Two letters of recommendation from non-family members
- Most recent high school, or higher, academic transcript
