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COURT CONTACT & BENCH WARRANTS

- Individuals may contact the Court by telephone to discuss balances and payment options.
- Individuals with a bench warrant may make arrangements to be arraigned remotely or appear in person.



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FEE WAIVER

During the amnesty period:

- Late fees and eligible bench warrant fees will be waived upon payment in full of the original fines and costs owed.
- Upon payment in full, an eligible warrant issued for failure to pay will be cancelled.



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DRIVER'S LICENSE REINSTATEMENT

If your driver's license has been suspended by the Michigan Secretary of State:

- You remain responsible for the \$45 driver's license reinstatement fee.
- The \$45 fee will be remitted to the State of Michigan.



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UNABLE TO PAY IN FULL?

- Individuals who are unable to pay the original fines and costs in full will not qualify for the Amnesty Program or the waiver of eligible late fees or bench warrant fees.
- The Court will work with individuals who make a significant payment toward the original fines and costs to establish a new payment plan for the remaining balance.
