## 2020 Farmers' Market Shopper Guidelines

The farmers market is set up to follow social distancing rules so you can shop safely. You can help by following these guidelines to keep yourself and others healthy, and to ensure that the market can stay open for your shopping needs.



**STAY HOME IF YOU ARE SICK** or a member of your family is sick. Shoppers displaying

COVID-19 symptoms will not be allowed to enter the market. Ask a friend or neighbor to shop for you.



**WEAR YOUR FACE MASK OR FACE COVERING AT ALL TIMES.**

Following the governor's ruling, face coverings will be required while in the market area. Gloves are encouraged if you have them.



**MAINTAIN 6 FEET OF DISTANCE** from shoppers and vendors

**SHOP ALONE** to support safe social distancing at the market.

**LEAVE PETS and KIDS** home whenever possible.



**MAKE A SHOPPING LIST** so you can shop quickly.

**PRE-ORDER** with your favorite vendors if the option is available. Check the farmers' market website for vendor details.



**FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS** posted on signs and comply with requests from vendors and market

staff. All are meant to keep you and us healthy.



**SANITIZE HANDS** before entering the market.



**NO EATING** inside the market. There will be no samples available.

**CREDIT CARDS AND CONTACTLESS PAYMENTS ARE PREFERRED.** Checks or small bills are suggested where credit is not possible.

**DO NOT TOUCH PRODUCTS.** Vendors will handle all items for you. Point or tell the vendors what you want to purchase.

**VENDORS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO TOUCH REUSABLE BAGS.** Vendors will provide bags for your purchase. You may choose to place vendor bags inside your own reusable bags to carry home, but only you should touch your own bags.



**BE PREPARED TO WAIT.** A limited number of customers will be allowed in the market area at one time. Please wait patiently until market staff permits entry into shopping area.

**SHOP QUICKLY.** The market may be busy. Conduct your shopping from a vendor and move along to allow the next customer to shop.



**BE COURTEOUS** to your vendors and other shoppers. We are all doing our best to keep each other safe.



**THANK YOUR FARMERS AND VENDORS!** They have worked hard to make sure you can shop safely.
