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Terms and Conditions for All Springfield Sprouts Children's foundation Scholarship

Acceptance into a Springfield Sprouts Children's foundation Scholarship opportunity is based on the following terms and conditions.

- **Available Funding**

- Where funds are not available, the applicant may be placed on a waiting list until funds become available.
- Partial funding may be awarded with the understanding that the applicant and guardian family will be responsible for the rest of the expenses.

- **Legitimate Need**

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate beyond a reasonable doubt that there is a need.
- A signed stamped letter from the Local leaders should be attained that demonstrates legitimate need.
- A signed, stamped letter from the local pastor should be written that demonstrates need.

- **Completed Application**

- An application must be completed and signed.
- All supporting documents must be included for the application to be considered.
- A signed application is an indication that the applicant agrees to all of the rules and regulations and terms and conditions specified by Springfield Sprouts Children's foundation.

- **Length of Scholarship**

- Should an applicant be accepted for scholarship, the length of scholarship assistance will be one year from the date of acceptance.
- After one year, the applicant's situation will be reviewed by the Program officer and Management program for possible renewal.
- Renewals will be made on an annual basis based upon meeting the eligibility criteria.
- If at any time the student demonstrates poor behavior, as indicated in the terms and conditions, they may be excised from the program immediately. Any remaining scholarship donated toward this applicant may be applied towards remedying the situation and may be then redirected towards a more deserving family.

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Rules and Regulations for all Springfield Sprouts Children's Foundation Scholarship

Opportunities

Adherence to the rules and regulations demonstrate a student is looking to improve their future opportunities in a God-honoring way to promotes their holistic learning in order to positively impact a Ugandan in the future.

1) **Good Behavior** – All students enrolled in a Springfield Sprouts Children's foundation scholarship opportunity are expected to:

- ☐ Have an attitude of thankfulness and work diligently.
- ☐ Lead others by example with integrity and honesty in every action.
- ☐ Have an attitude of humility, considering others as better than themselves.
- ☐ Adhere to the rules and regulations of the institution they are attending.
- ☐ Contribute to the church and guardian family by assisting with work on school breaks:
 - Animal Care
 - Farming
 - General cooking, laundry, and cleaning
 - Fetching water and other items
 - House maintenance and repair
 - Assistance with other children in the home
 - Volunteering in the church

2) **Applicants to the program should:**

- ☐ Be Christ followers.
- ☐ Regularly attend church.
- ☐ Demonstrate financial integrity and transparency.
- ☐ Have a social worker visit them on breaks.
- ☐ Write thank you letters once annually to Springfield Sprouts Children's foundation.

3) **Poor Behavior** - Immediate Grounds for dismissal from the program include:

- ☐ Misappropriation of funds or resources
- ☐ Sexually inappropriate behavior
 - Having sex
 - Becoming pregnant or impregnating someone
 - Participating in sexual misconduct or sexual assault
 - Circumcising a female student or participating in female circumcision
- ☐ Drug and alcohol use
- ☐ Use of pornography
- ☐ Lying
- ☐ Stealing
- ☐ Cheating
- ☐ Fabricating School Scores
- ☐ Bullying or threatening

Each situation will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis by the Program me Director, Springfield Sprouts Children's foundation Uganda Director, and any overseeing staff.
