### Terms and Conditions for All Springfield Sprouts Children's foundation Scholarship

Acceptance into a Springfield Sprouts Children's foundation Scholarship opportunity is based on the following terms and conditions.

#### Available Funding

- Where funds are not available, the applicant may be placed on a waiting list until funds become available.
- o Partial funding may be awarded with the understanding that the applicant and guardian family will be responsible for the rest of the expenses.

#### Legitimate Need

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate beyond a reasonable doubt that there is a need.
- A signed stamped letter from the Local leaders should be attained that demonstrates legitimate need.
- A signed, stamped letter from the local pastor should be written that demonstrates need.

### Completed Application

- o An application must be completed and signed.
- o All supporting documents must be included for the application to be considered.
- A signed application is an indication that the applicant agrees to all of the rules and regulations and terms and conditions specified by Springfield Sprouts Children's foundation.

### • Length of Scholarship

- Should an applicant be accepted for scholarship, the length of scholarship assistance will be one year from the date of acceptance.
- After one year, the applicant's situation will be reviewed by the Program officer andManagement program for possible renewal.
- Renewals will be made on an annual basis based upon meeting the eligibility criteria.
- If at any time the student demonstrates poor behavior, as indicated in the terms and conditions, they may be excited from the program immediately. Any remaining scholarship donated toward this applicant may be applied towards remedying the situation and may be then redirected towards a more deserving family.
