By registering for the netball season, you agree to the following Terms and Conditions.

- KENC acknowledge the Wurundjeri People as the Traditional Custodians of the land we play and train on, and we pay our respects to Elder's past, present and future
- KENC is committed to the cultural safety of First Nations children, and all cultures that form society. We work to ensure all young people within our Club feel safe and nurtured in a positive environment where they feel comfortable with being themselves, expressing their culture, their spiritual and belief systems and are supported by the Club. We have a zero tolerance policy towards racism.
- As a Community Sports Club run solely by volunteers, it is a condition of registration that ALL parents or guardians to be included on a team roster to assist with scoring and other duties as required such as providing fruit or lollies to the team. It is expected that these duties are shared evenly amongst all team parents/carers. Failure to do so may see your child's registration not being renewed the following season.
- We require a (minimum of one) parent from each team to volunteer as Team Manager. If we do not have a parent volunteer from each team to take on this responsibility, we may be unable to enter that team into the competition.
- You agree that Keilor East Netball Club will provide your child's contact and medical details to the season coach and team manager. Note, for all players 18 years and under, the Club defaults to providing the contact details for the parents/guardians only. We do not gather or disseminate information on the personal mobile numbers or personal emails of children aged under 18 years.
- You agree that during the season, photographs may be taken by Club Reps of your child's team during training or competition for use on Club newsletters, KENC Facebook or Instagram page or for annual presentation night slide shows.
- You agree to abide by the Netball Victoria Code of Conduct available on the NV website. This code extends to coaches, umpires, players, competitor teams, the Essendon District Netball Association representatives, and other parents.
- You agree to sign up for TeamApp and Netball Connect or other messaging platforms as nominated to enable the Club to relay information easily and quickly to you.

GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT

You must ensure the standards of the <u>Fair Play Code</u> are applied by demonstrating the five core values that will lead to fair play for all:

- Respect
- Responsibility

As a person required to comply with this regulation, you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during any activity held by or under the auspices of Netball Victoria, an Affiliated Association/League or Club.

- 1. Fully comply with the Child Safety in Netball Code of Conduct
- 2. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others
- 3. Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealings with others
- 4. Be professional in, and accept responsibility for your actions
- 5. Make a commitment to providing quality service
- 6. Be aware of, and maintain Netball Victoria's standards, rules, regulations and policies
- 7. Operate within the rules and regulations of Netball Victoria, affiliated
- Associations/Leagues and Clubs
- 8. Do not use your involvement in netball to promote your own beliefs, behaviours or practices where these are inconsistent with those of Netball Victoria, affiliated Associations/Leagues and Clubs
- 9. Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility especially when dealing with persons under 18 years of age, as your words and actions are example
- 10. Avoid unaccompanied and unobserved activities with persons under 18 years of age, wherever possible
- 11. Refrain from any behaviour that may bring Netball Victoria, affiliated Associations/Leagues or Clubs into disrepute
- 12. Provide a safe environment for the conduct of the activity
- 13. Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick or injured
- 14. Be a positive role model
- 15. Understand the repercussions if you breach, or aware of any breaches of the Code of Conduct
