## MUSIC

	<b>Senior Choir</b>	Middle School aged singers through adults. The choir rehearses on Thursday evenings from 7:30-8:30pm and sings an average of two Sundays/month. No experience necessary, and members do not have to read music.
	<b>FPCH Ringers</b>	The chime choir is for middle school aged students through adults. The chimes rehearse on Thursday evenings from 6:30-7:30pm, and ring an average of one Sunday/month. No experience necessary, and members do not have to read music.
	<b>Unity Chime Choir</b>	This chime choir is for students in grades 3 and up. They rehearse following church on Sunday mornings and play on an average of one Sunday a month.
	<b>Joyful Noise Bell Choir</b>	This bell choir is for beginning ringers in grades K and up. They rehearse following church on Sunday mornings and play on an average of one Sunday a month.

## CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

	<b>Substitute Teacher</b>	We have four Sunday School classes: Pre-K-Gr. 1, Gr. 2-4, Gr. 3-5, and Confirmation. At times a substitute is needed when the regular teacher is absent. You will be provided with all lesson plans and materials and can choose the grade level you're most comfortable with.
	<b>Bible Study</b>	Bible studies are organized by Pastor Erin and are held on Wednesday evenings from 6:30-8:00pm.
	<b>Second Sunday</b>	This program is for the kids of our church (and their friends!). It meets from 11:30am-1:30pm on the second Sunday of each month. The activity begins with a light lunch, followed by a variety of creative experiences. We can use assistants, or if you have a special hobby or talent that you'd like to share with kids, we'd love to have you be part of the fun.

## GOURMET GROUPS

	<b>Men's Breakfast</b>	The Men's Breakfast group is for all men and boys and friends of the congregation. They meet on the 2 <sup>nd</sup> Saturday of the month at 8:30am.
	<b>Ladies' Breakfast</b>	The Ladies' Breakfast group is for all women and girls and friends of the congregation. They meet at the River Star Diner on the third Saturday of each month at 9:00am. Separate checks are provided.
	<b>Ladies Who Lunch Group (LWL)</b>	The Ladies' Who Lunch group meets at noon at a different local restaurant on the 4 <sup>th</sup> Tuesday of each month. Separate checks are provided, and transportation can be arranged.
	<b>Presbyterian Ladies Enjoying Food and Fun (PLEFF)</b>	The Presbyterian Ladies Enjoying Food and Fun meets at a different local restaurant on the 1 <sup>st</sup> Tuesday of each month. Separate checks are provided, and transportation can be arranged.
	<b>Community Dinners</b>	The Community Dinners are held on the 2 <sup>nd</sup> Saturday of the month. Meals are prepared and served to the local community at 5:30pm in our Chapel. We need help setting up, preparing meals, serving, and cleaning up.

## WORSHIP SERVICE AND CHURCH FACILITIES

	<b>Greeter</b>	Before church begins, take a turn to greet worshippers at the Main Street and Ramp doors and hand out the morning's bulletin.
	<b>Usher</b>	Take a turn collecting the offering during the worship service.
	<b>Worship Leader</b>	Volunteers assist Pastor Erin, welcoming the congregation, sharing announcements, reading scripture, and leading the prayer of confession. All materials are provided, and you can choose the Sundays that you'd like to serve.
	<b>Camera Operator</b>	We live stream our services through the church Facebook page using a MEVO camera. Volunteers will be trained in how to set up the camera. You don't have to serve at every service.
	<b>Church Workdays</b>	About twice a year, workdays are held to maintain the grounds surrounding our church.

## COMMUNITY OUTREACH

	<b>Deacons' Clothing Drive</b>	Twice a year, the Deacons hold a fundraiser Clothing Drive. You can help sort donations, and on pick-up day, help load the truck.
	<b>Deacons' Yard Sale</b>	In the Spring, the Deacons hold a fundraiser, Yard Sale. Volunteers are needed to help with pricing, sorting donations, and assisting on the day of the sale.
	<b>Yarn Girls</b>	The Yarn Girl group meets to knit/crochet prayer shawls, lap robes, baptismal blankets and pocket crosses. Supplies are provided, and crafters from beginners through experienced are all welcome.
	<b>Free Little Pantry</b>	Volunteers are needed to help to keep the free pantry on the Chapel porch filled and clean.
