NEW MEMBERS

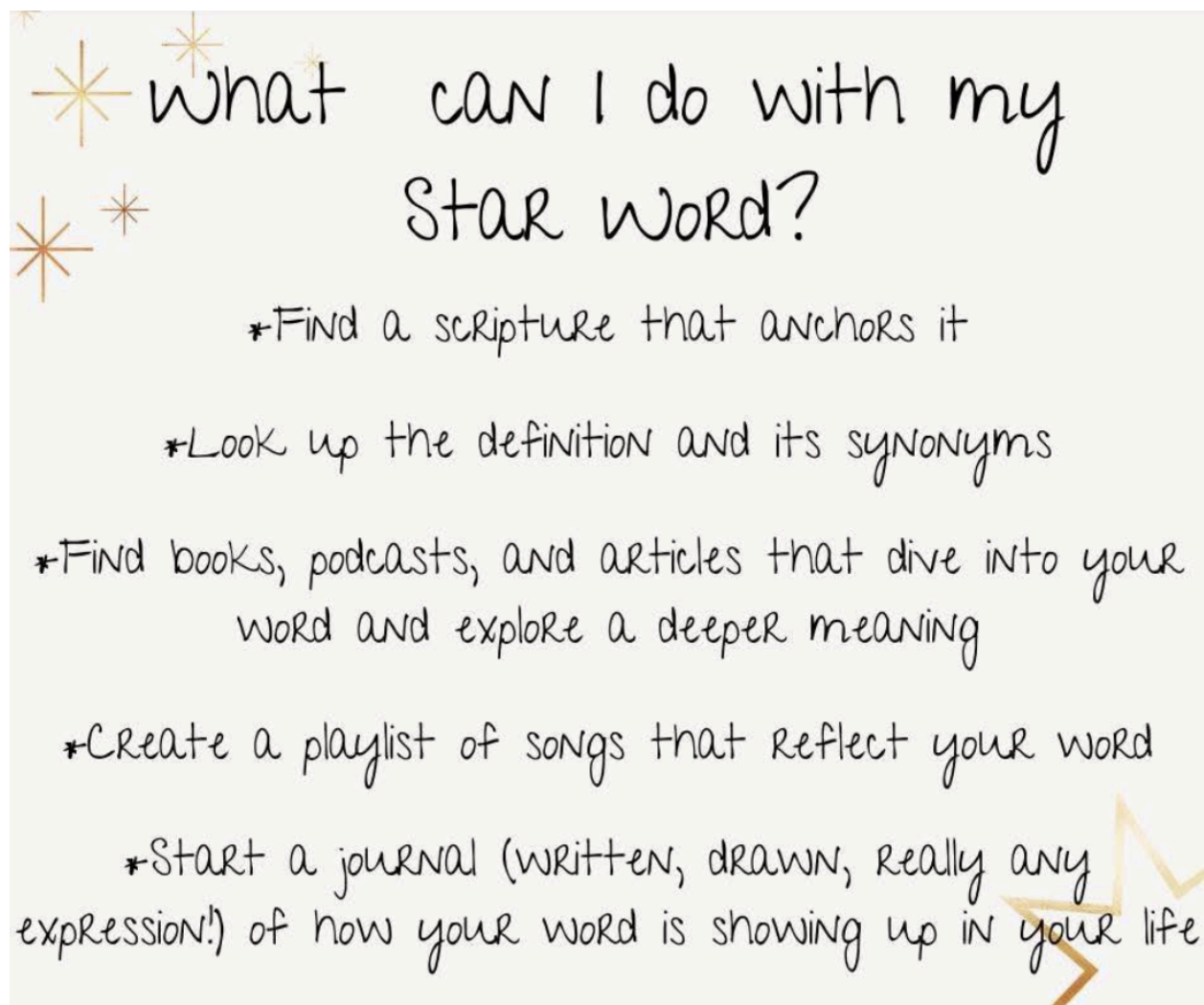
