

We confess our sin that our disunity within the Reformed family has impaired our ability to serve God's mission in fullness.

We join in praise to God, Creator, Redeemer, Spirit, who has "brought down the mighty from their thrones, lifted up the lowly, filled the hungry with good things and sent the rich away with empty hands." Accra Confession (excerpts)
