

### **CONFIRMANDS' STATEMENT OF FAITH**

God is the creator of the heavens and earth; He has authority over all existence. He crafts humanity in His own image, endowing all people with dignity and purpose, thus reflecting His divine nature and love.

#### STEW'S CLUE!

Kids (and grown-up kids too), did you find Stewie last week? He was hiding . Did you find him on the whiteboard for our children's message song? This week, Stewie has moved again. The Stew's Clue is Second Sunday.

#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

On this day when we celebrate the sacrament of the Lord's Supper: are you curious about why we use individual cups for Communion rather than a communal cup? Historian Deb Shepherd shared this information from the March 3, 1902 Session Minutes.: "Smallpox broke out in our village on Saturday, January 4th and spread through the town until 118 cases were reported. The Board of Health ordered all churches and schools closed and the order was continued until 1st Sabbath in March when our churches were opened and services held."

[Also noted in the minutes] approved individual communion cups. Elders Sutphin and Wade, a committee, ordered to secure a set on trial; if no further outbreak of the [epidemic], motion was made to adopt the Individual Communion Cups and on June 9, 1902 Elders Sutphin, Kennedy, and Wade formed a committee to confer with the Trustees about putting holders in pews for Individual Communion Cups-the same cup holders we will use this morning!
