



One God

Our relationship with God the Father only comes through His son Jesus Christ, who is God in the flesh. The Holy Spirit is also God, who dwells in us after being made righteous through Jesus. There is only ONE God—who reveals Himself in our lives in three distinct ways. This is not unlike the way I show up in the world as a man. I am a father, a husband, and an employee of an organization. I have different roles and responsibilities in each, but who I am—and my purpose to love God above all else and others as myself—remains the same. I am one person, showing up in three different ways. Because God is perfect, only those who are perfect can be in His presence and rest in His glory. But we are not perfect—we all sin. And while sin has earthly consequences, its ultimate consequence is [separation](#) from God. That separation is [Hell](#). God cannot ignore sin, because He is perfectly just. But because He is also perfectly loving, He made a way. He became flesh, lived a perfect life, and became the only one worthy to take on our penalty for sin. Because of God’s perfect love, we all can be saved from Hell, that eternal penalty of sin, and dwell in the peace and love that only comes from our Father in Heaven. To achieve this, we need to fully accept that free gift of Jesus Christ’s sacrifice and atonement for our sins through our faith. But this faith is not just belief. He wants our heart. And that comes from a real, personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
