HE HEALED ALL THAT WERE SICK

Dear Friend,

So, you think your sickness and pain is just too big for God? I think there are many that may believe that. But the Good News is that Bible does not teach us that!

As we look into the scriptures, and in particular, the Gospels, where we can study the life of Jesus, we see that "He went about doing good and **healing**" (Acts 10:38). Jesus Christ is alive, as well as the same, yesterday, today and forever (Hebrews 13:8), so He is still **healing** today!

Listed below for your study in faith and **healing** are the Bible verses about Jesus' life of **healing** others. Accept Jesus as your **Healer**. Receive your **healing** by faith, letting your heart agree with the truths found in these scriptures, and say with your mouth, "I am **healed**, now, in the Name of Jesus."

And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and **healing** all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and he healed them. Matthew 4:23-24

And when Jesus was come into Peter's house, he saw his wife's mother laid, and sick of a fever. When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses. Matthew 8:14, 16, 17

And behold, they brought to him a man sick of the palsy, lying on a bed: and Jesus seeing their faith said unto the sick of the palsy; Son, be of good cheer; thy sins be forgiven thee. But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (then saith he to the sick of the palsy,) Arise, take up thy bed, and go unto thine house. Matthew 9:2, 6

But when Jesus heard that, he said unto them, They that be whole need not a physician, but they that are sick. Matthew 9:12

And <u>Jesus went about</u> all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and <u>healing every sickness and every</u> disease among the people. Matthew 9:35

And when he had called unto him his twelve disciples, <u>he gave them power</u> against unclean spirits, to cast them out, and <u>to **heal** all manner of sickness and all manner of disease</u>. Matthew 10:1

But when Jesus knew it, he withdrew himself from thence: and great multitudes followed him, and he healed them all. Matthew 12:15

And <u>Jesus went forth</u>, and saw a great multitude, and <u>was moved with compassion</u> toward them, and he **healed** their sick. Matthew 14:14

And he healed many that were sick of divers' diseases, and cast out many devils; and suffered not the devils to speak, because they knew him. Mark 1:34

And[the disciples] to have power to heal sicknesses, and to cast out devils. Mark 3:15

And they cast out many devils, and <u>anointed with oil many that were sick</u>, and <u>healed</u> <u>them</u>. Mark 6:13

And whithersoever he entered, into villages, or cities, or country, they laid the sick in the streets, and besought him that they might touch if it were but the border of his garment: and as many as touched him were **made whole**. Mark 6:56

They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they [the disciples] shall lay hands on the sick, and they **shall recover**. Mark 16:18

Now when the sun was setting, all they that had any sick with divers' diseases brought them unto him; and he laid his hands on every one of them, and healed them. Luke 4:40

And he came down with them and a great multitude of people . . . <u>came to hear him</u>, <u>and to be **healed** of their diseases</u>; And the whole multitude sought to touch him: for there went virtue out of him, and **healed** them all. Luke 6:17, 19

And he sent them [the disciple] to preach the kingdom of God, and to **heal** the sick. Luke 9:2

And <u>heal</u> the sick that are therein, and say unto them, The kingdom of God is come nigh unto you. Luke 10:9
