For "doctrine, reproof, correction, and instruction in righteousness" (2 Timothy 3:16)

Speak To The Need As If It Existed!

So, there is a need—perhaps for the rent or mortgage, gas in the car, food on the table—whatever! Here's what to do.

- 1. Remind God that He <u>said</u> He will supply all your needs. "Needs" means, "something that must or should be." The rent <u>must</u> be paid.
- 2. Then, speak out, like Abraham spoke out over his circumstances (Romans 4:17), that "the rent is paid."
- 3. Like Abraham, he spoke out what did not yet exist, or seen in the natural, as if it did exist, because Abraham <u>spoke out what God promised</u>. Therefore, speak out what God promised about the need.
- 4. Then thank God for the paid rent.
