For “*doctrine, reproof, correction, and instruction in righteousness*” (2 Timothy 3:16)

“*I will come and **heal** him*” (Luke 8:7) was first spoken by Jesus. By Him showing us how, and giving us authority to do so, we too, as the Body of Christ should also be saying, “I will come and **heal** him.”

The world needs to see the Body of Christ empowered to **heal**. Doctors are so-called “experts.” Believers should be the experts in the area of **healing**.
