This month marked not only the reopening of our community classes but also a deep and meaningful celebration of World Environment Day. At Snehavardhini, we believe that such days are not just to be observed, but to be lived through real action.

With the collaboration of ZP school teachers, Krushi Vijnyan Kendra, Elppy Company, and Excel Company, we came together with one purpose: to begin the year by planting seeds—not just in the soil, but in the hearts of children, women, and communities

Voice from the Field

On the 2nd, we conducted a team-building program for teachers and social workers. A total of 24 participants attended the session, comprising 4 new teachers and the rest of the staff members. It was a full-day event focused on developing positive conflict resolution skills through interactive games and activities. The program also served as a platform for generating new ideas and sharing creative approaches. This experience was especially beneficial for the new teachers, as they were introduced to the vision, mission, and objectives of the Snehavardhini Social Trust (SST). The event fostered strong relationships among all participants and showcased the team's creativity.



Environment Day

On the 5th of the month, we organized an Environment Day celebration and officially launched "Environment Month," to be observed across different villages. The inauguration was marked by a seed distribution ceremony conducted by Dr. Pramod Mandavkar from the Krushi Vidnyan Kendra. He provided guidance on seed cultivation and distributed various kinds of seeds to the village women. Around 30 women received rice seeds, which were generously donated by Elppy Company, Dhav.



- On the 16th, we conducted a plantation drive at the ZP school to coincide with the reopening of the school. The goal was to instill in the children a sense of responsibility for planting and nurturing trees, thereby cultivating an early awareness of environmental care.



- On the 21st, with the support of Elppy Company, we planted fruit-bearing trees in two villages – Khargaon and Killa – as part of a future livelihood initiative.
- Additionally, the children took the lead in conducting plantation drives in their villages to demonstrate the importance of protecting nature. As part of this activity, they also prepared projects titled "My Nature" to express their understanding and commitment towards environmental conservation.





Play school

On the 9th, we reopened our Play

school It started with 2 students, and gradually, within a week, the number grew to 8. Some children were still getting settled in. A few were crying because it was their first time away from their mothers for two hours. It was a new place, with new people and a different environment, which made it difficult for them. However, they are slowly beginning to adapt and learn new things. Some children are very happy to have made new friends. In their world, playing and learning go hand in hand.

Girl's hostel

On the 16th, we reopened our girls' hostel. This year, something magical has happened: 40 students were enrolled, and they are excited to come to the hostel. Some of them even cried, but we can see the positive change in them.

This transformation is largely due to the parents being educated about the importance of their children's education. This year, we have 6 students in 10th grade, and we are thrilled that our tribal children are receiving and valuing education. We are truly grateful to the pioneers who planted the seed of education, and now it is beginning to bear fruit.





International Yoga

On the 21st, we celebrated International Yoga. Snehavardhini Social Trust has been consistently practicing yoga with children before classes to enhance their concentration and support academic performance across all the villages.
