143rd DISTRICT COURT'S STANDING ORDER REGARDING CRIMINAL WAIVERS OF ARRAIGNMENT

Beginning September 1, 2025, the Court requires that all Waivers of Arraignment contain not only the signature of Defense Counsel, but also the signature of the Defendant, showing that they understand their right to be arraigned and are freely and knowingly waiving that right.

Any Waiver that does not include the signature of the Defendant will summarily be rejected and the matter set for further Arraignment in front of the Court.
