

# A-Z Guide: 3rd on Main & 4th of July

## **ALCOHOL**

- Intoxicated or alcohol impaired individuals may be denied admission into event areas or subsequently required to leave upon request. Violators are subject to applicable legal action.

## **ANIMALS**

- All animals are welcome.
- All animals must remain under the control of the handler at all times.

## **CASH**

- Cash, American Express, Visa, and Mastercard are accepted by the Laverne Chamber.

## **CREDIT CARDS**

- Major credit cards (Master Card, Visa and American Express) are accepted by the Laverne Chamber.

## **EMERGENCY MEDICAL PROCEDURES**

- Medical and safety personnel will be available. For assistance in any medical emergency, please contact 911, Laverne Police, or Laverne EMS. It is extremely important to give the exact location of the medical emergency so medical personnel know where the emergency is occurring.

## **EVACUATION**

- In the event of an emergency, event staff and/or Laverne Police will utilize the public address systems to inform patrons of the situation and any instructions. In the unlikely event of an evacuation, please remain calm, assist others, and follow the instructions of Laverne Police and the event staff.

## **FIRST AID ROOMS**

- First aid is located inside the Laverne Chamber office during 3rd on Main.
- First aid is located inside the Laverne Pool and Laverne EMS booth during the 4th of July.

## **FOOD AND BEVERAGES**

- Patrons may bring outside food or beverages to events. Vendors are located throughout the event and offer a variety of food and beverages.

## **INCLEMENT WEATHER**

- In the event of inclement weather (i.e., dangerous winds, tornado, electrical storm, etc.), all guests will be advised that it is in their best interest to seek shelter. Emergency instructions will be delivered via the public address when possible.

## **LOST AND FOUND**

- Individuals who have lost items should email [lavernechamber@gmail.com](mailto:lavernechamber@gmail.com) or the Laverne Police Department to inquire about lost items.

## **LOST CHILDREN**

- Parents/guardians with a lost child should contact an event staff person or the Laverne Police to notify them that their child is missing. Measures will be taken to locate the child. If a child gets separated from his/her party, he/she should notify the nearest police or event staff member. Parents should pre-determine an area to meet in the event they get separated.

## **MOTORIZED VEHICLES**

- Motorized vehicles (golf carts, gators, etc.) must be street legal to drive on city streets.

## **OFFICE HOURS**

- For your convenience, the Laverne Chamber Office on Jane Jayroe Blvd will be open before 3rd on Main and remain open until the street dance begins. Contact the Laverne Chamber for additional information.

## **PARKING**

- 3rd on Main: Jane Jayroe Blvd will be closed to traffic and parking during the event.

Parking will be available in the following areas:

- Along Jane Jayroe Blvd east of North Broadway Ave
- Along North Broadway Ave
- Along Jane Jayroe Blvd west of North Oklahoma Street
  - Please note: Parking behind businesses on Jane Jayroe is only allowed with permission.
- 4th of July: Park Road Circle will be closed to traffic and parking. Public parking will be available at:
  - Laverne Public Schools
  - Parkview
    - Please do not park on private or business property without permission, or block driveways and streets.

## **RESTROOMS**

- Restrooms during 3rd on Main, portapotties are located on the south side of Jane Jayroe near the stage. Some open businesses will have public restrooms.
- Restrooms during the 4th of July are located in the middle of the park near the pool.

## **Road Closers**

- Jane Jayroe Blvd (between N Oklahoma Street & N Broadway Ave) will be closed to vehicular traffic starting 5 PM Thursday, July 3rd, and will remain closed until 12:00 AM Friday, July 4th.
- N Oklahoma Street (between Jane Jayroe Blvd & NW 1st Street) will be closed to vehicular traffic starting 5 PM Thursday, July 3rd, and will remain closed until 12:00 AM Friday, July 4th.
- Park Road Circle (between Park Rd & SW 1st Street) will be closed to vehicular traffic starting 10 AM Friday, July 4th, and will remain closed until 8:30 PM Friday, July 4th.

## **TAILGATING**

- In order to ensure a safe and fun atmosphere, tailgating is limited to designated areas on Main Street and in the park. Please view the Laverne Chamber tailgating maps to view publicly available and prohibited areas for tailgating, along with tailgating guidelines. You may begin claiming your tailgate spots starting Thursday, July 3, at 6 PM & Friday, July 4, at Noon. Please visit [LaverneOK.org](http://LaverneOK.org) for additional tailgating information and guidelines. All tailgate areas must be vacated by 1 hour post-event.

## **TRAFFIC CONTROL**

- The Town of Laverne Works will be responsible for traffic control around Jane Jayroe Blvd & the Laverne City Park. The Town of Laverne Works will coordinate with the Laverne Police Department for traffic control around the event areas.

## **TRASH**

- Trash receptacles for the disposal of trash and other items are placed throughout the event areas. Please help keep Laverne and Oklahoma clean by properly disposing of your trash.

## **VENDORS**

- Vendors will open at the same time as the events on 3rd on Main and the 4th of July.
- Vendors will be located along N Oklahoma St during 3rd on Main.
- Vendors will be located around the Town of Laverne Park during the 4th of July.

## **WEAPONS/FIREARMS**

- No weapons/firearms of any kind are permitted at any Laverne Area Chamber of Commerce events.

## **WEATHER (LIGHTNING)**

- When lightning is detected within ten (10) miles of the event(s), the event(s) will be suspended until further notice. The event(s) will resume after thirty (30) minutes of no detected lightning strikes within a ten (10) mile radius of the event.

## **WEATHER (REFUGE AREAS)**

- In the event the events are suspended due to severe weather, please follow the instructions of event staff and public safety officials.

## **WEATHER WARNINGS**

- The general public will be informed of severe weather conditions via the public address announcements.
