Guidelines and Rules

Rules:

- The entire boat must be made of corrugated cardboard. Any thickness of corrugated is permissible
- Corrugated bonded to other substances like vinyl, coated with wax, etc. may not be used.
- All boats may use duct tape on the seams only. Tape must NOT wrap entire boat or the hull.
- Any paint "one part" substance may be used as waterproofing. NO epoxy glue, Fiberglass resins, or other 'two part' finishes may be used. NO urethane based products or tar substance is allowed.
- The hull cannot be wrapped in plastic or any other material.
- Decorations are allowed and encouraged provided they are not used as structural or floatation element.
- Crew costumes are encouraged.
- All crew members must remain on the boat- no one is allowed to use "swim" power.
- Oars or paddles may be used to propel the boats
- All crew members' arm and legs must be in the boat at all times. Body parts may not be used to propel the boats
- All entrants must remove their boats or pieces after the races are complete. ALL debris MUST be removed from the water and placed in the designated dumpster.
- All crew members must sign a "Hold Harmless" release prior to the race. If a crew member is under 18 years old the release must be signed by a parent or guardian.
- Race will begin in the water with crews in the boat. One person may steady the two crew boat and two people may steady a multi-crew boat. No pushing will be allowed.
- Boats will be inspected for rules compliance prior to the race. Boats that are deemed non-compliant with event rules will not be allowed to race. The judge's decisions are final.
- This is a FUN event! Any behavior that is deemed to be detrimental to the event or other participants will result in team disqualification.
- All Crew members will be required to attend a pre-race meeting 30 minutes prior to the race time
- All boats must be available for People's Choice award prior to the race for voting ballot inside the pool area at the east side of the pool.
- Remaining boats will be invited to the Demolition Derby heat at the end of the event
