

Nurses with Purpose, Inc. Terms and Conditions

A PROPERLY SIGNED DOCUMENT IS REQUIRED PRIOR TO ANY INDIVIDUAL'S FULL ACCEPTANCE TO THE NURSES WITH PURPOSE, INC. VOLUNTEER MEDICAL MISSION TEAM

CAREFULLY READ THE NURSES WITH PURPOSE, INC. TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1.This document, the terms and conditions, hereafter describes the terms and conditions of the Nurses with Purpose, Inc. (hereinafter NWP, Inc.) medical mission experience. It is the agreement between NWP, Inc. and the name of the traveler, referred to as "Volunteer/ Attendee" It is your responsibility to comply with ALL the requirements each document has set forth.

2.Volunteer agrees to release, indemnify, and hold harmless NWP, Inc., its officers, directors, employees, contractors, vendors, and/or any other third parties acting on behalf of NWP, Inc. against any and all expenses, losses, damages, accidents, injuries, claims, or deaths resulting in whole or in part, either directly or indirectly, from any aspect of travel and/or activities facilitated by NWP, Inc. The volunteer further agrees that in no event and under no circumstances shall NWP, Inc., nor its officers, directors, employees, vendors, contractors, and other third parties acting on behalf of NWP, Inc. bear any liability, either jointly or severally, total or aggregate, under the Agreement that exceeds the amount of total fees paid by Volunteer to NWP, Inc. for the particular mission trip in question.

3.Volunteer must refrain from any and all actions that would pose a hazard to self and/or other team members/attendees. Volunteers should discontinue and stop an activity immediately if they feel unwell and seek assistance. Volunteers must adhere to and abide by all applicable domestic and international laws and regulations in the countries of travel and while volunteering in the country of residency. If questioning, apprehension/arrest, detainment, punishment, or incarceration by lawful authorities occurs, NWP, Inc. is not responsible or liable, either legally, financially, or otherwise, for the volunteer's actions or release. NWP, Inc., bears no liability for any activity or outcome that may adversely affect the health or well-being of volunteer.

4.Volunteer understands that all required credentials, visas, permits, insurance, and other travel medical such as immunizations/COVID-19 test results, and identifying documentation are the sole responsibility and at the sole expense of Volunteer.

5.Volunteer's passport should be valid for at least 6 months beyond your intended date of exit from country visiting, in line with the countries immigration regulations. To avoid problems at the airport on arrival, Volunteer is advised to ensure their passport meets this requirement. It is Volunteer's sole responsibility to make sure all travel documentation is update prior to departure.

6.Volunteer is solely responsible on obtaining travel insurance at their own expense if they elect to do so. They understand that NWP,Inc. offers short term travel insurance which covers emergent medical services for the duration of scheduled trip which is an additional charge.

7.Volunteer understands it is their responsibility to arrange and book their own flight with their airline of choice which is not covered by Nurses with Purpose, Inc., arrive on time for travel departure, events and/or activities. NWP, Inc. assumes no responsibility, liability, or expense for Volunteers non-participation (con't)

(con't) and/or inability to travel, participate in events hosted by NWP, Inc. due to insufficient, inaccurate, missed flights, medical causes, or any identifying documentation by volunteer and including any reasons seen or unforeseen, and/or forces of nature that are out of the control of the volunteer and NWP, Inc.

8. In the event the attendee ultimately does not participate, and/or cancel participation within the first 30 days of signing the commitment documents and/or initiating payments, whichever comes first, Attendee understands that Nurses with Purpose, Inc. retains twenty-five (25%) percent of dues paid at that point. Any cancellation occurring over Thirty (30) days after the signing of the commitment documents and/or initiating payments, whichever comes first, is nonrefundable nor transferable to another NWP, Inc trip.

9. This total waiver of liability is intended to be a full and complete waiver and release of NWP, Inc. from any liability for any damages or injuries that may occur as a result of the trip or related activities, and that the volunteer is giving up any rights to legal recourse that they may have or obtain against NWP, Inc. or its related parties. Volunteer hereby releases, forever discharges, and agrees to hold harmless, NWP, Inc. and/or directors or any affiliates thereof from all liability, claims and/or demands of personal injury, sickness and/or death, as well as property damage and expense, of any nature whatsoever which may be incurred by the undersigned and/or participant in the above assigned trip and activity. Furthermore, the volunteer hereby assumes all risk of personal injury, sickness, death, damage, and expense as a result of participation in recreation and volunteer work activities involved therein. The volunteer understand that they have voluntarily applied and accepted volunteer participation and understands the risk that are involved. By signing below, Volunteer agrees that he/she will abide by all jurisdictional protocols as it relates to the COVID-19 virus and international travel requirements.

10. By signing below I agree and I understand that I have voluntarily applied, and accepted volunteer participation and understand the risk involved. I also state that I am in good health, able to sustain travel and unstable conditions and have informed Nurses with Purpose, Inc. in writing any health conditions that may interfere with my duties or health. This Agreement shall be in effect from the signed date of Agreement (either electronically or physically) and in perpetuity, and shall cover all future travel, activities, and/or events that the volunteer may participate in which are affiliated in any way and any time with NWP., Inc.

I, the Volunteer/Attendee, have read, acknowledged, and agree to the above guidelines and agree to the responsibilities, rules, and terms.
