

Nurses with Purpose, Inc. Cancellation Policy & Agreement

Cancellation Policy & Agreement:

The monies for the trip will cover, local transportation for travel (NWP-related), *lodging (shared rooms), Excursions (covered excursions are based on country specific itinerary), access to Members Portal, conference calls, travel consultant, host/translators/drivers and Nurses with Purpose, Inc. Welcome Package which contains; Tshirt, lanyard and Name Badge

1. Attendee understands that they must book their own flight and it is not part of, or the responsibility for Nurses with Purpose, Inc, and not included in the cost.
2. Attendee is responsible for providing 2-3 pair of navy-blue scrubs and comfortable work shoes
3. Attendee is responsible for the following:
 - Passport Fees, visa fees (if applicable), travel insurance (if elect) and any fees required for the region of travel
 - Airfare
 - Any vaccinations, proof of required test for entry into countries and/or medication that may be required
 - Food/Water
 - Optional outings such as dining, shopping, extra activities and travel cost not on the NWP itinerary will not be covered
4. In the event the attendee ultimately does not participate, and/or cancel participation within the first 30 days of signing the commitment documents and/or initiating payments, whichever comes first, Attendee understands that Nurses with Purpose, Inc. retains twenty-five (25%) percent of dues paid at that point. Any cancellation occurring over Thirty (30) days after the signing of the commitment documents and/or initiating payments, whichever comes first, is nonrefundable nor transferable to another NWP, Inc trip.
5. In the case of early or late arrivals and departures to the mission trip Nurses with Purpose, Inc. is not responsible for any fees that occur, this includes, flight changes, missed flight, baggage fees, baggage delays, transportation fees, early hotel check in and/or out times or additional stay/lodging cost.
6. If life events, seen or unforeseen, prohibits Attendee from making the trip, canceling, departing early or departing late, Nurses with Purpose, Inc. is not responsible, and the trip is not refunded nor transferable.
7. If a natural disaster occurs seen or unforeseen and/or imminent disturbances or acts of God, Nurses with Purpose, Inc. is not responsible, and the trip is not refunded nor transferable.
8. If the country has imminent disturbances which could be detrimental to the team, that is known well in advance 30 days prior to the departure of the trip, we will postpone the event to a more suited date when bookings permits, making all reasonable efforts to reschedule the trip within 12 months. Attendee is aware and accepts that pricing may be increased and fair market value will apply. It will then be up to the attendee, to rebook the trip within the 12 months period offered when registration is opened. If attendee does not rebook within allotted time frame, no refunds nor transfers will be honored, forfeiting Attendees monies paid.
9. It is the responsibility for Attendee, to cancel any recurring payments or installment plans arranged through their personal financial institutions to prevent any unwanted charges as Nurses with Purpose, Inc. does not have access to banking details.
