1. FY2024 Budget

City Clerk Stegelmeier went over the current budget and how it compares to the actual spending with the Mayor & Council. She also went over information from ICRMP on an increase in the City's liability insurance costs. They also went through the employee's health insurance changes. The police department has submitted a FY2024 budget request for them to look over. Mayor Mattingly then explained that he and any councilmembers who want to ride in the parade will ride in one of the police Humvees at the 4th of July parade. They also received information on the pool hours for the 4th of July. The Mayor & Council will go over budget information again at the July regular meeting and scheduled a budget workshop on July 26th as well.
