CALL TO ORDER & WELCOME

In Attendance: Tom Mattingly, Teresa Hansen, John Scafe, Nate Finley and James Allen.

Also in attendance: City Clerk Stegelmeier, Joel Vega, Denise Vega and Dallas Hill.

Mayor Mattingly welcomed everyone in attendance and opened the meeting at 6:00 pm.

1. **Banner Discussion – Dallas Hill **ACTION ITEM****

Dallas Hill explained that he has come up with 4 banner designs. The companies that he has spoken with will charge \$70-75 each to produce the banners. He would like to make all of the options available to the public. Then everyone will pick their own. He does not want to take away from the fundraising for the fireworks so he will be marking up the banners to \$100 each and he will give \$50 per banner to the fireworks fundraiser. Councilwoman Hansen said she liked all the designs and the idea for sale. She is just concerned that he should not give more than what it costs to the fundraiser. She feels he should just give \$25 each to the fundraiser. Dallas said he would like to donate the rest in the name of his business. Dallas said the design will go on the top of the banner and the businesses or even families could put their names at the bottom. Councilman Scafe expressed his opinions that Dallas will have no problem in selling enough of the banners to do all of Main Street. Dallas is hoping to have them put up as the crew takes down the graduation banners.

Councilman Allen made a motion to approve the designs as presented, the city crew will hang up the banners and then return them to Dallas Hill to return them to the purchasers. Councilman Finley seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

2. **Sewer Dump Discussion – City Clerk Stegelmeier **ACTION ITEM****

City Clerk Stegelmeier explained that Todd has looked over the lines and has found that the city can just put a meter in the pit where he turns off the sewer dump station for the winter. That meter will meter what is going out in the dump station and then that amount can be removed from what the property meter is putting out to bill the Idaho Parks & Rec for just what is being used in the building, park and through the hydrants. This project has been a long time coming and should be done soon.

3. **ADJOURNMENT**

Councilwoman Hansen made a motion to adjourn. Councilman Scafe seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The meeting ended at 6:32 pm.
