Mayor Mattingly welcomed everyone and opened the meeting at 6:00 pm.

### **1. Amend Agenda – 2. Wastewater Screen Project Change Order – City Clerk Stegelmeier 3. Surplus Sale – City Clerk Stegelmeier **Action Item****

City Clerk Stegelmeier explained that these items came up after the agenda was posted.

Councilwoman Hansen made a motion to approve the Amend Agenda as presented. Councilman Kaelberer seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

### **2. Wastewater Screen Project Change Order – City Clerk Stegelmeier **Action Item****

City Clerk Stegelmeier explained that this change order is for the gravel to raise the road at the lagoons so that there would not be a problem trying to plow in the winter. The building has been placed higher than the lagoons so that the sewage can flow naturally but that makes it so the pipe to the building had to be raised higher than the road which will cause problems with plowing. Some of the gravel will be purchased locally which will save costs.

Councilman Kaelberer made a motion to approve the Wastewater Screen Project Change Order as presented. Councilman Finley seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

### **3. City of Ashton Resolution 24-04- Surplus Sale – City Clerk Stegelmeier **Action Item****

City Clerk Stegelmeier explained that to get the car on sale before the school year started, the City needs to get the surplus sale started. Councilman Kaelberer expressed his concern that \$1000 was too much for a minimum bid on the Alero. Councilman Scafe expressed his concern that the pipe be sold as a lot and not piece by piece.

Councilman Kaelberer made a motion to approve City of Ashton Resolution 24-04 with minimum bid on the vehicle to \$750. Councilman Finley seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Councilman Scafe made a motion that the irrigation pipe be sold as a lot and not piece by piece.

Councilwoman Hansen seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

### **4. FY2025 Budget **Action Item****

City Clerk Stegelmeier went over the budget with the City Council. The Council made changes, suggestions and updated the budget. They will view it one more time prior to posting notice for a public hearing in August.
