

6. Consent to Alcohol & Drug Testing

I hereby consent to undergo alcohol and drug testing as required by The Damascus Road Foundation (TDRF) policies and procedures. I understand that this testing is conducted to maintain a safe and healthy recovery house environment and is a condition of participation in the TDRF House Program.

1. Purpose of Testing:

I understand that the purpose of alcohol and drug testing is to detect the presence of alcohol and/or controlled substances in my system. This testing may be conducted for pre-admission screening, random testing, post-relapse testing, post overnight/weekend stays testing, reasonable suspicion testing, or as otherwise required by TDRF policies. This not only supports individual accountability and personal safety, but it also helps TDRF gather the data to demonstrate your progress.

2. Types of Tests:

I acknowledge that in-house alcohol and drug testing may include, but is not limited to, urine, breath, or saliva tests. Offsite blood testing will be required when necessary.

3. Who will do the testing?:

As most testing will be performed onsite and our homes are gender specific, a staff member of the same gender will be present during testing.

4. Urine Test Protocol:

As urine testing can be done at any time, failure to comply within 1 hour of a request for a urine sample will be considered as a positive test. Any resident may ask the House Manager for a urine test at any time. Once selected for a urine test: The individual selected will remain in the kitchen area until ready to give sample. They will always have a senior house member in direct contact until the sample is given. They will not go into any other rooms or drink any fluids that do not come directly from the kitchen sink tap. Samples must be given in a direct line of sight with two witnesses designated by the House Manager. Any individual caught substituting or adulterating a specimen is subject to dismissal from the residence.

5. Voluntary Consent:

I voluntarily consent to undergo alcohol and drug testing. I understand that I have the right to refuse the test, but I am aware that such refusal/or failure to provide an adequate sample will be treated the same as a positive test result and handled as outlined in TDRF policies and procedures. Any attempt to cheat/circumvent a test will result in a dismissal from the residence.

6. Confidentiality:

I understand that the results of the alcohol and drug testing will be kept confidential to the extent permitted by law. Only authorized staff involved in the testing process and decision-making will have access to the results.

7. Release of Information:

I hereby authorize the release of the test results to TDRF and its designated representatives. I understand that these results may be used for admission/dismissal decisions, to track your personal progress, and anonymously to track general recovery home success.

8. Compliance with Policies:

I agree to comply with TDRF’s alcohol and drug policies, including any rehabilitation or counseling programs that may be recommended in the event of a positive test result. When a test is disputed or thought to be a false positive, a resident may opt for offsite testing by a local laboratory, hospital, or clinic at their own expense.

9. Acknowledgment:

I acknowledge that I have been given the opportunity to ask questions about the testing process and have received satisfactory answers to my inquiries.

I have read and understood the contents of this Alcohol and Drug Testing Consent Form, and I willingly consent to undergo testing.
