1 Introduction

This document provides a one-page summary for each of the 46 Pillar Policies in the Canadian Renewal Coalitions *Canada Great Again* plan. Each summary details the pillars focus, mechanics in action, relation to the 2026-2033 timeline (phased as Y12: Foundation, Y35: Acceleration, Y68: Dominance), projected impacts, and key metrics. The plan assumes implementation post-2025 snap election, targeting 1.5% GDP growth, reduced irregular crossings, and +\$20,000/household by 2033. Each pillar is assessed using a grading rubric for factual alignment with 2025 data from official sources (e.g., Statistics Canada, OECD, government reports), prioritizing empirical evidence over hypotheticals.

1.1 Grading Rubric for Pillar Accuracy

- **90-100%:** Claims fully corroborated by current trends and data; projections conservative and evidence-based; inspirations directly comparable and successful; minimal risks ignored.
- **80-89%:** Strong factual basis with minor overstatements; projections feasible with policy support; inspirations relevant but context-adjusted; balanced risk acknowledgment.
- **70-79%:** Partial alignment with data; ambitious projections grounded in trends; inspirations somewhat applicable; some unaddressed feasibility issues.
- **60-69%:** Overstated or speculative claims; data supports direction but not scale; inspirations loosely related; significant risks or contradictions.
- **Below 60%:** Claims contradicted by data; unrealistic projections; misleading inspirations; high feasibility barriers or policy conflicts.

Grades are assigned objectively based on cross-verified sources from the provided data.

2 Pillar 1: Economic Growth

Focus: Reduce regulatory burden to support productivity and innovation, targeting 1.5% annual GDP growth and 500K new jobs.

Mechanics in Action: Conduct audits of burdensome regulations in energy, mining, and construction. Use AI-driven impact assessments to prioritize cuts that reduce compliance costs by 1015%. Partner with provinces for pilots, reallocating saved funds to SME grants. Monitor via quarterly StatsCan reports, adjusting for feedback from citizen assemblies.

Relation to Timeline:

- Y12 (Foundation): Pilot in Ontario/BC, cutting 300 regulations; establish AI tools for reviews.
- Y35 (Acceleration): National rollout, tying to \$100B infrastructure; add 200K jobs.
- Y68 (Dominance): Annual sunsets ensure sustained 1.5% growth; integrate with trade balances for compounding effects.

Impacts: For individuals, lower business costs translate to 25% wage increases in affected sectors (\$1,0002,500/year for average workers). Households gain \$1,000 in disposable income via job creation and reduced prices. Security: High, as deregulation shields against foreign over-reliance.

Metrics: 1.2% growth by Y3, 500K jobs by Y8; target 85/100 rating.

Inspired by: Ontario (\$20M saved via burden reduction).

3 Pillar 2: Inflation Control

Focus: Optimize supply chains to stabilize inflation at 12%, reducing volatility <1%.

Mechanics in Action: Deploy AI for predictive logistics in food/energy. Collaborate with provinces for energy deregulation, monitoring CPI via Bank of Canada dashboards. Adjust tariffs to buffer global shocks.

Relation to Timeline:

- Y12: AI pilots in supply chains.
- Y35: Full deregulation; integrate with trade deals for stable imports.
- Y68: Automated bands; surpluses fund buffers.

Impacts: Households save \$200400/year on essentials (e.g., 23% lower food). Security: Medium, stabilizing costs prevents debt spikes.

Metrics: <1% volatility by Y3; 80/100 rating.

Inspired by: Philippines (2.4% inflation via AI).

4 Pillar 3: Unemployment

Focus: \$5K hiring credits and 300K bootcamps to achieve <6% unemployment.

Mechanics in Action: Fund credits for SMEs; partner with industry for targeted training in trades/AI. Use AI matching for placements; track via Labour Force Survey.

Relation to Timeline:

- Y12: Launch bootcamps; local quotas.
- Y35: Scale to 300K; integrate retraining.
- Y68: <5% sustained.

Impacts: +\$3,000 wages; high security from job stability.

Metrics: <6% by Y4; 85/100.

Inspired by: U.S. Trump-era (3.5% via zones).

5 Pillar 4: Corporate Tax

Focus: 15% flat rate to repatriate \$30B capital, creating 300K jobs.

Mechanics in Action: Audits for offshore funds; R&D write-offs; tax holidays for manufacturing.

Relation to Timeline:

- Y12: Audits and initial cuts.
- Y35: Full repatriation; incentives.
- Y68: Annual clawbacks.

Impacts: +\$800 household via investment; medium security.
