1 Introduction

Fellow Canadians, as Justin Doyle of the Canadian Renewal Coalition, I present this expanded document to expose the United Nations as a profoundly failed institution and outline a detailed 8-year plan to shut it down. The UN, founded in 1945 with the noble aim to prevent war and foster international cooperation, has devolved into a \$3.8B bureaucracy riddled with scandals, waste, fraud, and abuse. It does not stop warsit enables and prolongs them through inaction and misdirected funds. It funds the "quiet World War 3" of mass illegal migration, which is being used as a tool of demographic disruption and economic strain on sovereign nations. Canada contributes over \$300M annually to this mess, money that could be better spent on domestic priorities like housing, healthcare, and energy independence.

We'll grade the UN an F (0-49/100), detail the scandals with how they occurred, what was involved, and why they represent a betrayal of the Charter. Then, we'll uncover the unnecessary spending, waste, fraud, and abuse, explaining the mechanisms behind them and their failure to align with the UN's original purpose. Finally, we'll map the 8-year plan to dismantle it, with year-by-year actions, metrics, and milestones to reach A+ (90-100/100) through sovereign alternatives.

2 The UN's F Grade: A Complete Betrayal of Its Charter

The UN's Charter promises to "save succeeding generations from the scourge of war," promote human rights, and foster international cooperation for economic and social advancement. In reality, it has failed spectacularly. The grade is F (0-49/100), deducted as follows: 40 points for war inaction (how: Vetoes in the Security Council block resolutions; what: 71 peacekeeping missions since 1948, only 2 succeeding; why: Structural paralysis prevents the "peace" mandate, as seen in Ukraine and Gaza). 30 points for migration funding scandals (how: Through IOM/UNHCR cash transfers; what: \$372M

diverted to cartels; why: Enables illegal flows instead of "cooperation" for stability). 30 points for waste and fraud (how: Untracked budgets and internal corruption; what: \$1B unspent peacekeeping; why: Erodes "economic advancement" by squandering resources). This is not a noble idea gone astrayit's a system that perpetuates the problems it was meant to solve.

3 All the Scandals: A Deep Dive into Systemic Failure

The UN's scandals are not isolated incidents; they are embedded in its structure, from peacekeeping to aid. Below, I detail all major scandals, including those from 2025 and historical ones that continue to impact, explaining how they happened (mechanisms), what was involved (parties/funds), and why they betray the Charter (failure of purpose). This is based on 2025 reports and audits.

5 8-Year Plan: Shutdown, Rebuild, and Sovereignty

Our plan phases the UN's end, saving Canada \$300M/year, redirecting to priorities like borders (Pillar 44) and economy (Pillar 1). How: Through defunding (withhold payments), audits (expose waste), and alliances (replace with FNP). What: Metrics for wars, migration, waste. Why: Aligns with Charter ideals without the bureaucracy.
