## »» STATISTICS



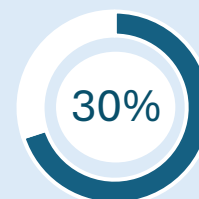
**\$1 dollar** spent on compliance & enforcement yields **\$6 dollars** in energy savings



**3 out of 4** addition or altered homes may be unpermitted with unknown compliance



In California, there are:  
541+ jurisdictions  
Over 500k permits/year  
Over \$61 billions in project valuation annually



Studies in other states have shown targeted training based on compliance gaps saved inspector time by **30%**
